

# DORM INSPECTION RULES

Rules must be posted in each dorm on the first day of camp. Dorms will be inspected by a member of the Rules committee and a report will be given at the tabernacle.

1. The dorm floors swept clean.
2. Beds made neatly with ends and sides tucked.
3. All luggage under beds or neatly on bunks not being used.
4. Window ledge and dresser top may be used for toiletries, no pop cans, candy, etc.
5. Middle shelf may be used for storage of all objects, arranged neatly, including shoes.
6. Shower rooms cleaned of all soap, towels, and clothes.
7. Clean lavatory and stools daily.
8. Remove all toilet articles and clothes from the bathrooms.
9. Empty all waste baskets. (Area designated)
10. Hang clothes on rack under middle shelf only. Turn all hangers in the same direction.
11. Towels and wash cloths may be hung neatly on end of bunk. Beach towels are to be on the outside line when wet.

# SPONSOR'S RESPONSIBILITIES

1. One Adult Sponsor must be provided for every ten (10) youth campers (one adult man for every ten or fewer boys, and one adult woman for every ten or fewer girls)..
2. Sponsors are subject to the same rules and regulations as are all other campers.
3. Sponsors are responsible for their young people at all times. Sit so you can discipline them during worship services. Encourage your young people to participate in recreational activities or know their whereabouts. You **MUST** maintain order in the dorm at all times.
4. The sponsors are to conduct the evening devotions in the dormitory or appoint some member in his/her cabin to do so. Sponsors are to see that lights are out at 10:30. p.m.
5. Sponsors are to advise their young people to not throw rocks at any time, to throw their trash in the trash containers and to not throw anything in the creek.
6. Please advise your young people to use the restroom or get a drink before the services begin so that it will not be necessary to leave during the service.
7. Advise your young people that the woods and trails are off-limits except announced hikes with adult supervision.
8. Sponsors are to lead his/her campers by proper example to attain the highest standard of Christian conduct.
