

# Oklahoma Camp Rules

The following rules are set forth in order to maintain a safe, Christ-like environment as well as an environment that is conducive to worship and spiritual growth for all campers. These rules apply to all campers registered with Oklahoma Camp and are not debatable. They can, however, be changed by a vote of the sponsors at camp.

1. The conduct, clothing and personal items of all campers must be such that would bring honor and glory to God.
2. Campers are required to attend worship services and classes.
3. Campers are not permitted to leave the campgrounds at any time unless accompanied by a sponsor. The Camp Director or the Assistant Camp Director must be notified if anyone leaves camp.
4. Campers are not permitted in the wooded areas or on the hiking trail at any time without a sponsor.
5. Campers are not to be out of their cabins after lights out.
6. CONDUCT: Public displays of affection, use of any form of tobacco and other unchristian-like behavior will not be allowed. All campers should strive to be Christ-like at all times.

## 7. CLOTHING:

### MALES:

- Pants (no shorts) are to be worn to all worship services and classes.
- Shirts are to be worn at all times

### FEMALES:

- Dresses, pants and capri pants (no shorts) are all acceptable for morning worship services and classes.

- Dresses and pants (no capri pants or shorts) are both acceptable for evening worship services.
  - Sundresses and low-cut dresses or blouses are not permitted at any time.
  - Dress length must be to the top of the knees.
- Bathing suits are to be worn only in the pool area. If they are worn to and from the pool they are not to be visible.

## EVERYONE:

- Modest shorts are permitted at all times EXCEPT for worship services and classes.
- Tank tops and muscle shirts will not be permitted at any time.
- Shoes must be worn at all times, except when in the cabin or in the pool.
- Sagging clothes will not be permitted at any time.
- Hats/caps of all kinds are to be removed in the tabernacle.
- Clothing with questionable slogans or messages will not be permitted. If in doubt DON'T!!

## 8. PERSONAL ITEMS;

WHAT TO BRING: Pillow, bedding, light jacket, clothes, toiletries, Bible, notepad, pen, money for snacks, signed registration form and a camera if desired.

WHAT NOT TO BRING: Radios, tape/cd/mp3 players, video games, and items that are considered unchristian-like.
